Description of AndornaktÅ¼lya's Coat-of-Arms

(1)Å Å Å Å Å

AndornaktÅ¼lya's coat-of-arms is based on the old coat-of-arms of the MocsÅ¼ry family and also the history, culture and traditions of the village.

(2)Å Å Å Å Å The body of the coat-of-arms is shield shaped and divided into two parts. In the dark blue part there is a

yellow standing lion with its mouth open, its red tongue put out, and its curved, double tail ending in brushes sticking out. In the light, silver part there is a vine on a stock with leaves and grapes evenly on each side representing viniculture, the typical agricultural activity of the area. At the top of the shield there is a tournament helmet. The sides are artistically decorated with gold and red bay leaves. Under the shield we can read 'AndornaktÅ¼lya' on a ribbon.

(3)Å Å Å Å Å The meaning of the colours in the coat of arms can be interpreted as follows:

Å Å

Gold (Sun): sense, intellect, faith, authority, virtue and chastity;

Silver (Moon): wisdom, purity, innocence, and prudence;

Red (Mars): patriotism, self-sacrifice, willingness to act and generosity;

Blue (Jupiter): freedom, love, hope, happiness, beauty and health.
